POLICY STATEMENT

The Village of Mannville recognizes that the Mannville Fire Department is authorized to provide emergency services within the Community’s municipal boundary area, as listed in Appendix A.

RELATED INFORMATION

This policy is required to meet the intent of the Alberta Occupational Health & Safety Code and the Alberta Code of Practice for Fire Fighters.

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. VILLAGE OF MANNVILLE FIRE CHIEF will ensure that the level of service identified is adhered to and that employees providing services are competent.
2. MANNVILLE VILLAGE COUNCIL will review and approve the service levels periodically.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish and identify the emergency services which the Mannville Fire Department is authorized to provide and to identify the level or standard to which each service will be performed.
