**Monthly Tax Payment
Bylaw # 2012-775**



**Taxpayers may pay taxes on a
monthly basis subject to the
following conditions:**

- The Taxpayer must notify the Village Office of their desire to be on the monthly payment plan and provide the first payment within the month of January.
- For the first five months of the current year the taxpayer shall pay a monthly payment equivalent to one twelfth of the tax based on previous year's tax notice.
- For the last seven months of the year the taxpayer shall make seven monthly payments equivalent to the balance of the tax levy for the current year.

**All payments are due in the Village
Bank account before the last
banking day of each month.**
