

Monthly Tax Payment Bylaw # 2012-775



Taxpayers may pay taxes on a monthly basis subject to the following conditions:

- a) The Taxpayer must notify the Village Office of their desire to be on the monthly payment plan and provide the first payment within the month of January.
- b) For the first five months of the current year the taxpayer shall pay a monthly payment equivalent to one twelfth of the tax based on previous year's tax notice.
- c) For the last seven months of the year the taxpayer shall make seven monthly payments equivalent to the balance of the tax levy for the current year.

All payments are due in the Village Bank account before the last banking day of each month.

If you wish to be included on this Tax payment program please contact the office on or before January 31st and have provided the first month payment
