








VILLAGE OF MANNVILLE 2019 ASSESSMENT AND TAX NOTICES

- As per the Municipal Government Act, Section 311(1) notice is hereby given that the assessment roll has been prepared for the Village of Mannville and the assessment notices have been sent by mail on May 31, 2019 in the form of a Combined Property Assessment and Tax Notice.
- The assessment roll is open for inspection at the Village Office 5127- 50th Street, during regular business hours, 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Assessment complaints must be made in writing on the appropriate form to the Clerk of the Assessment Review Board by **August 7, 2019** with the required fee, paid to the Village of Mannville.
- Taxes are due and payable on or before **July 31, 2019** (To avoid Penalty).
- A 12% penalty will be applied to current taxes outstanding on August 1, 2019.
- Additional 6% penalty will be applied to current taxes outstanding on November 1, 2019.
- A 6% penalty will be applied to all tax arrears on January 1st of each year.

If you are on a monthly payment plan, please contact the Village Office to confirm that your installments are sufficient to ensure your balance is \$0.00 by December 31, 2019. Penalties will not be applied to those tax roll numbers for which a monthly payment plan agreement is in place and account is current.
