















Highlights from the Regular Council meeting held on April 18, 2017,

- Council approve entering into a Peace Officer Services Agreement with the Town of Vermilion for the term April 1, 2017 to March 31, 2018.
- Council directs Administration to add examples of “off season” storage fees to read “shed, storage building and RV trailers” to the yearly RV Park Seasonal Campsite contract. Also, to decrease the fee to \$300 plus GST effective October 1, 2017.

"It's camping season!"

Residents need to be aware of the parking regulations concerning Recreational Vehicles and Utility trailers on the streets of Mannville. Residents may park their RV/Utility trailer for a period of 48 consecutive hours.

However, RV/Utility trailers must be **attached to a vehicle** at all times. Leaving them parked and unattached can result in a fine.

You may park your RV/Utility trailer, attached to a vehicle, on the street in front of your house on Thursday in preparation for weekend camping.

However, you cannot park your RV/Utility trailer on the street Sunday night and keep it parked there all week to go camping the following weekend.

In addition, your RV/Utility trailer cannot be parked in a manner which constitutes an obstruction, presents a safety concern, or impedes the progress of other users of the roadway, highway, or highway right of way.

An example of this would be an RV which obstructs the sidewalk or protrudes into a traffic lane."

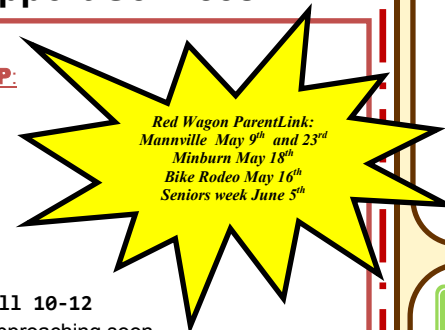
