Municipal Accountability Program (MAP)

The Village of Mannville has received some positive news in the wake of their Municipal Accountability Program (MAP) review, which was conducted by Alberta Municipal Affairs in January, 2019.

The MAP review looks at various areas of legislative requirements that are mandatory under the Municipal Government Act. All municipalities under a population of 5,000 in the Province of Alberta are required to undergo the review at some point in a four-year cycle.

The Village was notified early in 2019 that they had been randomly selected to undergo the review during 2019.

The Village received correspondence from the Ministry of Municipal Affairs commending the Village for addressing all items in a timely manner and advising that the MAP review has been completed to the satisfaction of the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

Additionally, the Village was informed that they were the first municipality in Alberta undergoing the MAP review in 2019 to complete all the legislative benchmarks required by Ministry.



a) The Taxpayer must notify the Village Office of their desire to be on the monthly payment plan and provide the first payment within the month of January.

b) For the first five months of the current year the taxpayer shall pay a monthly payment equivalent to one twelfth of the tax based on previous year's tax notice.

c) For the last seven months of the year the taxpayer shall make seven monthly payments equivalent to the balance of the tax levy for the current year.

All payments are due in the Village Bank account before the last banking day of each month.

Some of the items being discovered in sewers are listed below. Public Works calls these items "unflushables." <u>Even those items that claim to be flushable on the packaging usually aren't</u>. Unflushables cause sewer and pump blockages resulting in backups that can be costly for homeowners and the Village.

The Village is asking residents to "Trash it, don't splash it."

Items allowed to be flushed:

human waste (urine, feces, vomit)toilet paper

Some items <u>not</u> allowed to be flushed (unflushables):

disposable diapers
disposable wipes
rags/paper towels
feminine products (including tampons)
hair
condoms
dental floss
batteries
needles
