


# Highlights from the Regular Council meeting held on January 21, 2020

## RE: ATTENTION SENIORS - "Important Changes to Your Alberta Health Benefit Coverage"

Spouse and dependants of Alberta seniors, changes are coming to the Alberta's Coverage for Seniors program. Alberta Health has commenced mailing out letters to individuals who are registered as a dependant of a senior enrolled in the coverage for Senior's program.

These must be addressed immediately, the letter explains clearly what will be required from you and the necessary steps to ensure you will continue to have health benefit coverage as of March 1, 2020. Keep a copy of all documentation regarding your choice of health benefit coverage for your files.

Effective March 1, 2020, seniors' family members who are younger than 65 years will no longer be eligible to receive benefits from the Health Benefit Coverage from their spouse or partner.


