Some of the unwanted items being discovered in sewers are listed below. Public Works calls these items “unflushables.”

Even those items that claim to be flushable on the packaging usually aren’t. Unflushables cause sewer and pump blockages resulting in backups that can be costly for homeowners and the Village.

The Village is asking residents to “**Trash it, don’t splash it.**”

Items allowed to be flushed:

- human waste (urine, feces, vomit)
- toilet paper

Some items not allowed to be flushed (unflushables):

- disposable diapers
- disposable wipes
- rags/paper towels
- feminine products (including tampons)
- hair
- condoms
- dental floss
- batteries
