Highlights from the Organizational & Regular Council meeting held on October 20, 2020

- On October 20th 2020, Village of Mannville Council has appointed members to various Committees and the following members of Council as;
Mayor – Rex Smith
Deputy Mayor – Jim Jackson
- Council accept the presented 2021 Northern Lights Library System budget and requested 2021 levy in the amount of \$4,330.44 (\$5.23 per capita). No change from 2020 Levy.
- 2020 Tax Sale, Council set the Reserve Bid and Conditions for the sale scheduled for Monday, December 14, 2020 @ 10:00 am.
- Council approve the cancellation of property tax arrears as follows:
 Roll No. 4300000 in the amount of \$8,044.73
 Roll No. 70000 in the amount of \$2,443.22
- Council authorize Mayor Smith and CAO Quickstad to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Minister of Municipal Affairs for funding under the Municipal Operating Support Transfer Program.

Residents Reminder....

Garbage Carts need to be placed 3 feet (1 meter) from all stationary obstacles, such as vehicles and fences to allow the automated arms sufficient room to grasp cart. All garbage must **be properly bagged**, tied and placed within the cart. No Loose garbage, grass etc. Wheels facing in towards curbside. Do not place garbage on top of the lid.
