Highlights from the Regular Council meeting held on December 8, 2020

- Council agrees to participate in an application for grant funding under the Alberta Community Partnership Program Intermunicipal Collaboration (IC) component for Mannville East Industrial Park Joint Area Structure Plan.
- Council appoint Jennifer Hodel to the position of Mannville's Director of Emergency Management, effective January 1, 2021.
- Council adopt the 2020 Operating Budget as the 2021 Interim Operating Budget for the Village of Mannville.
- Council approve the 2021 Operating Budget submitted by the Mannville Library Board.
- Council approve Debbie Dubeau to the Mannville Library Board for a three (3) year term.

Some of the items being discovered in sewers are listed below. Public Works calls these items "unflushables."

Even those items that claim to be flushable on the packaging usually aren't. Unflushables cause sewer and pump blockages resulting in backups that can be costly for homeowners and the Village.

The Village is asking residents to "<u>Trash it, don't splash it."</u>

Items allowed to be flushed:

- •human waste (urine, feces, vomit)
- •toilet paper

Some items <u>not</u> allowed to be flushed (unflushables):

- disposable diapers
- disposable wipes
- •rags/paper towels
- •feminine products (including tampons)
- •hair
- •condoms
- •dental floss
- •batteries
- •needles
