Highlights from the Regular Council meeting held on January 19, 2021

- Council approved Bylaw No. 2021-850 Candidate Nomination Deposit Bylaw
- Council was advised by the CAO that the repairs to the **Pedestrian Railway Crossing** along Highway 881 have been delayed even further due to the work that only CN Rail can complete. CN continues to demand that the crossing be closed. Residents of the Village have contacted the Village Office and CN representatives to voice their concerns with this situation that has been going on for some time now. At this point, the Village is waiting for CN to complete the required repairs before the pedestrian crossing can be reopened.

The next Municipal Election will take place in the Village of Mannville on Monday, October 18, 2021.

The election will be for five (5) Council positions.

Pursuant to the *Local Authorities Election Act* (LAEA) the Nomination period (during which nomination papers can be submitted to the Returning Officer) has been extended, effective for the 2021 Election. Nomination period is now from January 1, 2021 to Monday, September 20, 2021 at 12:00 pm (Noon).

As per Village of Mannville Candidate Nomination Deposit Bylaw No. 2021-850, all nomination papers must be accompanied by a \$100 deposit in the form of a certified cheque, money order or cash. Due to COVID-19 the province has made a recent change that allows deposits to be paid by debit or credit card for the 2021 Election only. The deposit may be refunded to the candidate following the results of the election, pursuant to the provisions of the LAEA.

Interested persons may pick up a Candidate Information Package and/or the Nomination Paper & Candidate's Acceptance document (Form 4) at the Village Office located at 5127 – 50 St., Mannville by calling 780-763-3500 to book an appointment or by visiting the Village of Mannville website at www.mannville.com

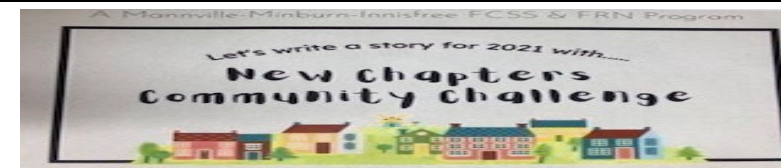
