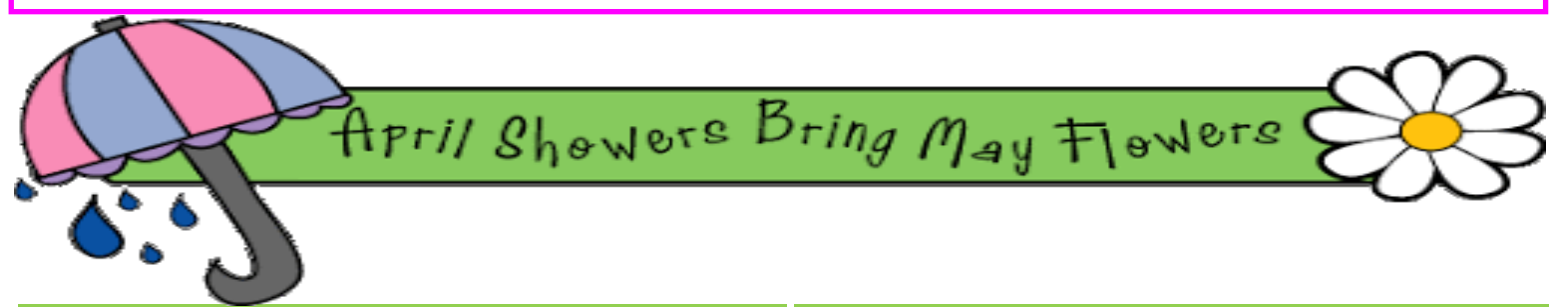

The next Municipal Election will take place in the Village of Mannville on Monday, October 18, 2021.

The election will be for five (5) Council positions.

Pursuant to the *Local Authorities Election Act* (LAEA) the Nomination period (during which nomination papers can be submitted to the Returning Officer) has been extended, effective for the 2021 Election. Nomination period is now from January 1, 2021 to Monday, September 20, 2021 at 12:00 pm (Noon).

As per Village of Mannville Candidate Nomination Deposit Bylaw No. 2021-850, all nomination papers must be accompanied by a \$100 deposit in the form of a certified cheque, money order or cash. Due to COVID-19 the province has made a recent change that allows deposits to be paid by debit or credit card for the 2021 Election only. The deposit **may** be refunded to the candidate following the results of the election, pursuant to the provisions of the LAEA.

We ask everyone to do their part in keeping our community clean!

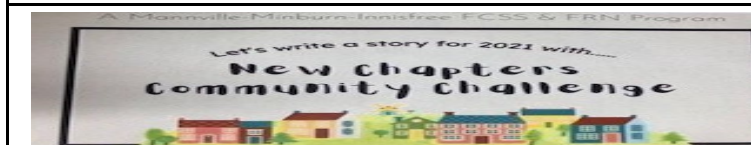
