### VILLAGE OF MANNVILLE 2021 ASSESSMENT AND TAX NOTICES

- As per the Municipal Government Act, notice is hereby given that the assessment roll has been prepared for the Village of Mannville and the notices have been sent by mail on May 28, 2021 in the form of a Combined Property Assessment and Tax Notice.
- The assessment roll is open for inspection at the Village Office 5127- 50<sup>th</sup> Street, by appointment during regular business hours, 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Assessment complaints must be made in writing on the appropriate form to the Clerk of the Assessment Review Board by **August 6, 2021** with the required fee, paid to the Village of Mannville.
- Property taxes are due now. The Village encourages taxpayers to make payments as soon as possible, if able to do so.
- **To avoid penalty**, payment must be made in full on or before **July 31, 2021**
- A 12% penalty will be applied to current taxes outstanding on August 1, 2021.
- A 6% penalty will be applied to current taxes outstanding on November 1, 2021
- A 6% penalty will be applied to all tax arrears on January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.

*If you are on a monthly payment plan, please contact the Village Office to confirm that your installments are sufficient to ensure your balance is \$0.00 by December 31, 2021.  
 Penalties will not be applied to those tax roll numbers for which a monthly payment plan agreement is in place and account is current.*



The next Municipal Election will take place in the Village of Mannville on Monday, October 18, 2021.

The election will be for five (5) Council positions.

Pursuant to the *Local Authorities Election Act* (LAEA) the Nomination period (during which nomination papers can be submitted to the Returning Officer) has been extended, effective for the 2021 Election. Nomination period is now from January 1, 2021 to Monday, September 20, 2021 at 12:00 pm (Noon).

As per Village of Mannville Candidate Nomination Deposit Bylaw No. 2021-850, all nomination papers must be accompanied by a \$100 deposit in the form of a certified cheque, money order or cash. Due to COVID-19 the province has made a recent change that allows deposits to be paid by debit or credit card for the 2021 Election only. The deposit may be refunded to the candidate following the results of the election, pursuant to the provisions of the LAEA.

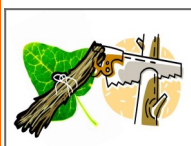

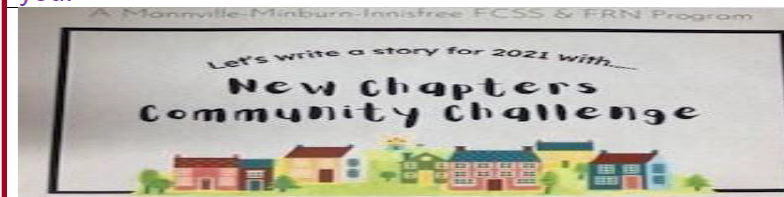
