

## ELECTION DAY — Monday, October 18, 2021

10:00 am - 8:00 pm @ Mannville Recreation Centre

The Village of Mannville residents will be voting at the polls this October to elect Councillors to represent their Municipality for the next four-year term (2021-2025).

Residents will also have an opportunity to cast a ballot for the Provincial Referendum and Senate Elections.

Eligible electors must be: a) at least 18 years of age; b) a Canadian citizen, and c) person's place of residence is located in Mannville on election day (Sec. 47, LAEA). All electors will be required to sign the voting register and show identification.

## Voter Identification and Eligibility

The Local Authority Election Act requires proof of identity in order to vote. You **must** produce identification for inspection.
