Village of Mannville & County of Minburn No. 27 Approve 10-Year, Joint Fire and Emergency Services Agreement

Mannville, AB (December 23, 2021) – The Village of Mannville and the County of Minburn No. 27 have come to terms on a Fire and Emergency Services Agreement.

The new agreement comes into effect on January 1, 2022 and will carry through until December 31, 2031.

Highlights of the agreement include:

- A 10 year agreement with the County of Minburn providing fire and emergency services to Village and County residents.
- A joint fire safety codes management plan with the County as the managing partner.
