- Council accept the presented 2022 Northern Lights Library System budget and approve the requested 2022 levy in the amount of \$4,199.69.
- Council approve the adoption of the proposed fire safety code Quality Management Plan, as presented.

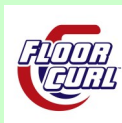
