





- A Public Hearing for LUB Amending Bylaw 2022-859 was held in Council Chambers of the Mannville Village Office on Tuesday, April 19, 2022. Council passed final readings to Amending Land Use Bylaw No. 2022-859.
- Council approved Bylaw No. 2022-858 Intermunicipal Subdivision & Development Appeal Board.
- Council approved Bylaw No. 2020-860 Traffic, Highways and Public Places.
- Council declare May 15 – 21, 2022 Public Works Week in the Village of Mannville.

Effective immediately, the speed limit is 40 km per hour on all roads in Village limits excepting Highway 881. (Provincially Controlled Highway)

The speed limit in back alleys remains 20 km per hour.

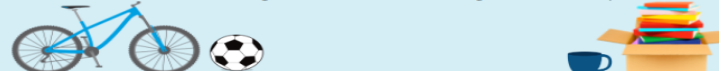
