### Back Alley Garbage Collection

Residents can assist public works for the pick-up of grass clippings, small branches, leaves etc. Please ensure branches are neatly piled and in lengths, no longer than 4 feet.

Maximum weight of bags 30lbs. If you have to drag your bag its too heavy. Public works will NOT pick-up any construction materials.


Property residents are also reminded to cut side and back alley boulevards.
