- Council maintain the current ATCO Gas Franchise Fee rate.
- Council waived the rent for the Mannville Seniors Centre for the remainder of 2022 and revisit the topic during 2023 budget deliberations.
- Council confirmed the recommended Level of Service as provided by the Minburn County Fire Department Discussion Paper dated August 12, 2022.
