Highlights from the Regular Council Meeting held on December 9, 2025

- Council endorsed a motion to approve the Mannville Multi 4H Club's Permanent Fire Pit Project at the Gazebo. Further, that Administration be directed to work with the 4H Club members on implementation of this project.
- Council passed the 2025-885 Master Rates Bylaw
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the Social Media Policy 1200-08 as amended.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve a partial adjustment of \$94.40 to Utility Account 30000
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the 2026 Operating Budget submitted by the Mannville Library Board with revenues and expenditures in the amount of \$92,270.
- Council moved to receive the North Saskatchewan Watershed Alliance letter and invoice as information.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the 2025 Amended Capital budget, as presented, for the total amount of \$705,500.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the 2026 Capital Budget for the total amount of \$995,000.
