Located 1.5 miles west of the Village of Mannville on Mannville Road and Range Road 92.



| Council News

Highlights from the Regular Council Meeting held on February 17, 2026

- Sgt. Ken Shambalaw, Vermilion RCMP Detachment Commander, presented an overview of his goals in his new role at the detachment. Mannville should see an increase in community patrols and school presence. Sgt. Shambalaw will be returning to the March 17, 2026 Council Meeting to discuss the Village of Mannville's priorities for RCMP presence in the community.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the Village of Mannville's Audited Financial Statements dated December 31, 2025, and the Audit Findings Report, as amended.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the Parks & Campground Policy 7000-03 as amended.
- Council passed Bylaw # 2026-888 Municipal Credit Card Borrowing Bylaw.
- Council endorsed a motion to re-appoint Carla Cavanagh and Rebecca Hochaussen to the Mannville Library Board as continuing members for a three (3) year term.
- Council endorsed a motion to direct Administration to enter into a Use of Space Agreement with the Mannville Centennial Public Library for a period of five (5) years.
- Council endorsed a motion to defer the Mannville Minor Ball Association's request for financial support to the Feb 26, 2026 Budget Planning Session for further review and discussion.
