Please email us what your organization has planned, or what you'd like to see planned for that day.

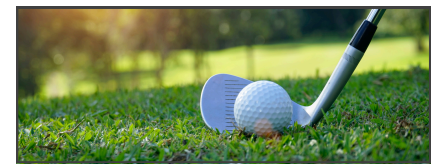

Council News

Highlights from the Regular Council Meeting held on March 17, 2026

- Sgt. Shamblaw discussed the Vermilion RCMP's policing priorities for the Village of Mannville for the coming year, in collaboration with Mayor and Council. The Vermilion RCMP will be focusing on Property Crime, drug related issues, and increasing their presence in the community. Sgt. Shamblaw also reviewed the Q3 crime statistics with Council. A Town Hall Meeting has been scheduled for April 16, 2026, from 7:00 - 9:00 p.m. at the Mannville Elks Hall.
- Ryan Baker, owner of Studebaker Industries Ltd., appeared before Council to inquire about the maintenance of Public Works Equipment.
- Council endorsed a motion to table the proposed amended Public Participation Policy to the April 21, 2026, Council Meeting.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the selection of Lambourne Environmental Ltd. to undertake the Lagoon Desludging and Dewatering Project. Further, that Administration be directed to enter into a contract with Lambourne Environmental Ltd. for these services.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the transfer of \$149,800 from Sewer Reserves to fund the Lagoon Desludging and Dewatering Project.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the selection of Green Space Alliance to undertake the Land Use Bylaw Review project for the Village of Mannville. Furthermore, that Administration be directed to enter into an Consultant Agreement with Green Space Alliance.
- Council endorsed a motion that pursuant to the Municipal Government Act Section 213(4), the signing authorities for the Village of Mannville be either Mayor or Deputy Mayor and the Chief Administrative Officer or the Executive Assistant or the Administrative Assistant.
