Council News

Highlights from the Regular Council Meeting held on April 21, 2026

- Council reviewed Business License Bylaw 2026-887 then endorsed a motion that 2026-887 Business License Bylaw be received as information.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the Public Participation Policy 1000-07 as presented.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve FRIST reading to 2026-890 Land Use Bylaw Amendment. A Public Hearing is scheduled to take place on May 19, 2026 at 6:30 p.m. in the Village of Mannville Council Chambers, in accordance with sections 606, 692 (1)(f) and 216 (4) of the Municipal Government Act.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the 2026 Operating Budget.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the amended 2026 Capital Budget.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the 2026 Property Tax Bylaw 2026-889.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the 3-Year Operating Plan 2027-2029.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the 5-Year Capital Plan 2027-2031.
- Council endorsed a motion to provide a letter of support to the Town of Vermilion in support of the Strategic Transportation Infrastructure Program (STIP) Application for improvements to the Town of Vermilion's Municipal Airport.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve Municipal Rising Tides Administration & Consulting's Standard Plan in the amount of \$6,500 (plus GST) to conduct a strategic planning session..
- Council reviewed a letter from the Mannville & District Agricultural Society for the 2026 Annual Operating Grant.
- Council set Monday, July 27, 2026 (10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.) as the date for a municipal by-election to fill the vacancy on Council. Additionally Council endorsed a motion that an Advance Vote be scheduled to take place on Thursday, July 23, 2026 from 12:00 (noon) to 8:00 p.m.
- Council endorsed a motion to appoint Brooke Magosse as the Returning Officer for the 2026 Municipal By-Election.
- Council endorsed a motion to appoint Kim Galloway as the Substitute Returning Officer for the 2026 Municipal By-election.
- Council declared June 1-7, 2026 as Seniors Week in the Village of Mannville.
- Council endorsed a motion to direct Administration to obtain additional quotes for the Village of Mannville's IT Services and to brought back to the May 21, 2026 Regular Council Meeting.
- Council endorsed a motion that the following elected officials be appointed to the following committees & Boards:
