- Councillor Rex Smith was elected as Mayor.
- Councillor Jocelyne Lanovaz was elected as Deputy Mayor.
- Village of Mannville Council appointed members to various Committee's.
- Council endorsed a motion that the Regular Council meeting dates be the third Tuesday of each month commencing at 6:30 p.m.
- Council endorsed a motion appointing the signing authorities for the Village of Mannville, pursuant to *Municipal Government Act S. 213 (4)*.
- Council appointed Jennifer Hodel as the Director of Emergency Management for the Village of Mannville.
- Council endorsed a motion designating the Mannville Branch of Vermilion Credit Union located at 5023-50 Street, Mannville, Alberta as the Village of Mannville's Financial Institution.
- Council endorsed a motion designating 5217-50 Street, Mannville, Alberta as the Municipal Office of the Village of Mannville.

Highlights from the Regular Council Meeting held on October 15, 2024:

- Council endorsed approved the Safety Boots Policy 1900-12 with amendments.
- Council endorsed a motion to execute a 5-year lease for the 93 Acres of land to the west of Mannville for \$2,000.00/year.
- Council endorsed a motion to extend the requirement to review the Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework between the Village of Mannville and County of Minburn No. 27 to March, 2026.
- Council endorsed a motion to table the request for a price on a Village-Owned, unserviced, commercial property to the next regular Council meeting on November 19, 2024.

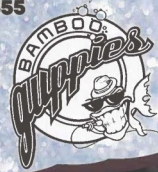
