Highlights from the Regular Council Meeting held on April 15, 2025:

- Council endorsed a motion approving the 2025 Operating Budget as follows:

Total Revenues:	\$ 3,333,927
Total Expenses:	<u>\$ 3,803,254</u>
Deficit:	-\$ 469,327
Less Amortization:	<u>\$ 479,421</u>
Surplus:	\$ 10,094

- Council endorsed a motion approving the 2025 Capital Budget, for the total amount of \$662,962.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve all three (3) readings on the 2025 Property Tax Bylaw No. 2025-880.
- Council endorsed a motion approving the 3-Year Operating Plan 2026-2028, and the 5-Year Capital Plan 2026-2030.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the transfer of the 2009 Tax Sale Surplus in the amount of \$6,328.16 to general revenue, pursuant to Section 428.1 of the *Municipal Government Act*.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the 2025 Mannville Grad Class's request to "Paint the Street" on May 23, 2025. Further, that Public Works be directed to place barricades at the intersection of 50 Street & 52 Avenue, and on the South side of the Village Administration Building (5127-50 Street), at the time of the event.
- Council endorsed a motion directing Administration to forward a letter to the Mannville & District Agricultural Society stating that the Village of Mannville has approved the 2025 Operating Budget, which includes a \$50,000 annual operating grant to be awarded to the Mannville & District Agricultural Society.

Voter Registration

NEW for 2025 - Municipalities are required to maintain a Permanent Elector Register of residents who are eligible to vote. You must be registered to vote on Election Day.

- ✓ To pre-register or check your registration status, visit the Voterlink website.
- ✓ Please note that registering through Voterlink will add you to the Provincial Electors Registry
- ✓ The County of Minburn, Village of Mannville and Village of Innisfree receive and use their list of eligible voters from Voterlink, so please confirm your information is correct to ensure you are ready to vote.
- ✓ If you are not on the Permanent Electors Registry, you must bring a number of documents on election day to confirm your eligibility to vote.
