Highlights from the Regular Council Meeting held on August 19, 2025:

- Council endorsed a motion to approve and authorize B. Magosse, CAO, to enter into a Property Tax Repayment Agreement on behalf of the Village of Mannville with the owner of the following property: Plan 7620198, Block 3, Lot 8.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the repairs to the four (4) out-of-service Fire Hydrants, at an estimated cost of \$13,600 (GST not included). Furthermore, the funds be allocated from Municipal Water Reserves.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the submission of a formal letter to the Canadian Armed Forces for a ceremonial flyby in support of the Remembrance Day Celebration to be held on November 11, 2025, in the Village of Mannville.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the renewal of the Software License Subscription with Catalis, for a period of four (4) years effective January 1, 2026.
- Council endorsed a motion to direct Administration to obtain quotes for the dredging of the Mannville Lagoons. Further, that quotations be presented at the next scheduled Regular Council meeting. Furthermore, that Administration is directed to implement a Wastewater Lagoon Maintenance Program, to enhance sludge digestion and reduce organic build up overtime.
- Council endorsed a motion to set the reserve bid amounts and any conditions that apply to the sale of the properties listed for Tax Sale by Public Auction on August 7th, 2024 at 10:00 AM in the Village of Mannville Administration Office. **Details regarding the Tax Sale by Public Auction can be found by visiting the Village of Mannville website (www.mannville.com) or by contacting the Administration Office.**
- Council endorsed a motion to appoint Nick Lenko to the Mannville Library Board for a three (3) year term beginning September 9, 2025.

2025 Municipal Election

The next municipal election, for the Village of Mannville, will be held on Monday, October 20, 2025.

Municipalities are required to maintain a Permanent Elector Register of residents who are eligible to vote. You must be registered to vote on Election Day.

To pre-register or check your registration status, visit the Voterlink website:

www.voterlink.ab.ca

If you do not register to vote, before Election Day, you will still be able to vote—however, you will be required to register at the voting station on Election Day!

Voter Registration

NEW for 2025 - Municipalities are required to maintain a Permanent Elector Register of residents who are eligible to vote. You must be registered to vote on Election Day.

- ✓ To pre-register or check your registration status, visit the Voterlink website.
- ✓ The County of Minburn, Village of Mannville and Village of Innisfree receive and use their list of eligible voters from Voterlink, so please confirm your information is correct to ensure you are ready to vote.
- ✓ Please note that registering through Voterlink will add you to the Provincial Electors Registry
- ✓ If you are not on the Permanent Electors Registry, you must bring a number of documents on election day to confirm your eligibility to vote.

Permanent Electors Register & Voting Information

At the Polling Station

- If you are already named on the Permanent Electors Register, you must provide **one piece of Government-issued photo ID**, including your full name, current address, and photo.
- Please note: **Another elector can no longer vouch for your identity.** You must be able to produce an acceptable form of identification.

If You Are Not Named on the Permanent Electors Register:

- Make a statement confirming your eligibility to vote in the prescribed form.
- Validate your identity and address of residence by producing one (1) of the following:
 - One piece of **Government-issued photo ID**, including your full name, current address, and photo.
 - One piece of identification authorized under the Election Act (s. 100(2)(b)) that establishes your name and current address of residence.
- A more detailed list of authorized identifications will be provided closer to Election Day.

For Identification Containing a Mailing Address (e.g., PO Box):

- If you registered to vote at your current physical address, you can use your **Driver's License or Identification Card** with your current mailing address.
- If you are not registered to vote or need to register at a new physical address:
 - If you have a **Government of Alberta-issued Driver's License or Motor Vehicle Operator's License**, you do not need additional identification.
 - If you do **not** have a Government of Alberta-issued license, you will need additional identification to prove your physical address (e.g., legal land description, lot-block-plan, and/or 911 address) prior to voting.

Vouching

- Another elector is only permitted to vouch for **someone's address, not their identity.**
- An elector who has been vouched for **cannot** vouch for another.

Back Alley Waste Disposal

The Village of Mannville would like to remind residents that while branches, garden refuse, and garbage placed in back alleys will be picked up, it must be kept to a reasonable amount.

To ensure timely and efficient service, we kindly ask that residents:

- ⇒ Call the Administrative Office at 780-763-3500 or email info@mannville.com before placing items in the alley for pick-up
- ⇒ Ensure that the amount of material set out is manageable and does not obstruct traffic or alley access
- ⇒ Avoid placing any construction debris, or oversized loads without prior approval

Improper or excessive dumping may result in delays or non-pickup.

- ⇒ Fats, Oils, and Grease (FOG)

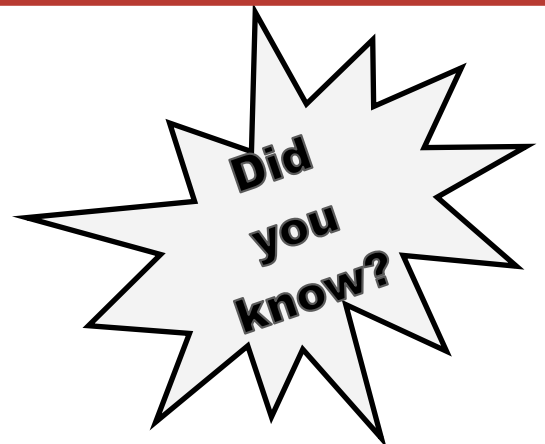
These materials do not break down properly and can cause:
