Administrative Assistant D. Poliakiwski administered the oath of office to the Councillor-Elect Gary Bauer, Douglas Gilbert, Jocelyne Lanovaz, Elizabeth Myhovich and Reid Roland.

- Councillor Reid Roland was elected as Mayor.
- Councillor Jocelyne Lanovaz was elected as Deputy Mayor.
- Village of Mannville Council appointed members to various Committee's.
- Council endorsed a motion that the Regular Council meeting dates be the third Tuesday of each month commencing at 6:30 p.m.
- Council endorsed a motion appointing the signing authorities for the Village of Mannville, pursuant to Municipal Government Act S. 213

 (4).
- Council appointed Brooke Magosse as the Director of Emergency Management for the Village of Mannville.
- Council endorsed a motion designating the Mannville Branch of Vermilion Credit Union located at 5023-50 Street, Mannville, Alberta as the Village of Mannville's Financial Institution.
- Council endorsed a motion designating 5217-50 Street, Mannville, Alberta as the Municipal Office of the Village of Mannville.

Highlights from the Regular Council Meeting held on October 28, 2025:

- Council endorsed a motion to direct Administration to prepare an send a letter to the parents of the Mannville School expressing Council's support for Mannville School, its teachers and schools across Alberta.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the Confined Space Safe Work Practice/Code of Practice policy 3900-05 as presented.
- Council endorsed a motion to table the Golf Course Advisory Committee policy 7000-04 to a future council meeting for further discussion.
- Council endorsed a motion to award the Asbestos Abatement and Drainage Pipe Replacement Project to ServiceMaster at the quoted amount of \$23,759.86 (plus applicable GST).
- Council endorsed a motion to accept the proposed 2026 Northern Lights Library budget as presented. Furthermore, Council approved the 2026 levy in the amount of \$4,594.40 (828 x \$5.55 per capita).
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the per capita funding request form the Healthcare Providers Attraction & Retention Committee in the amount of \$1,500 for 2026-2027 term.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the purchase of the Confined Space Equipment from 3M Equipment. Further, that the funds be taken from the 2025 Operating Budget under the sanitary sewer department.
- Council endorsed a motion to direct Administration to execute the 2026-2028 FCSS Funding Agreement on behalf of the Village of Mannville.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the per capita funding request from the Alberta HUB in the amount of \$765 for the 2026-2027 term.
- Council endorsed a motion to acknowledge that the SCADA System Project was budgeted in the 2024 Capital Budget was carried out and
 completed in 2025. Further, that Council approves the transfer of funds from the Water Reserves in 2025 to fund the project
 expenditures.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve an offer to purchase Lots 23A & 24A,
