Serwer Overflow – Excess Rainfall and Water Council reviewed the unbudgeted expenditures related to the sewer overflow response following the extreme rainfall event beginning on June 1, 2026.

2026.06.10/03 **MOTION by Deputy Mayor Lanovaz that Council approve the unbudgeted expenditures incurred to date in the amount of roughly \$50,000, from the Sewer Operating Budget, associated with emergency response, mitigation, and monitoring activities resulting from the sewer overflow incident that occurred on June 1, 2026. Further, that Council authorizes Administration to continue implementing required mitigation measures and emergency response actions as necessary to prevent further sewer back-ups and protect public health, safety, property, and municipal infrastructure. Furthermore, that Administration be directed to report back to Council regarding final costs, and any long-term infrastructure improvements identified through the post-incident overview.**


