MANNVILLE CARE CENTRE COMPLETES DESIGN UPDATES TO IMPROVE RESIDENTS' QUALITY OF LIFE

Over the past year, a variety of continuing cares home across Central Alberta have been undergoing quality of life improvements to create warmer, home-like spaces that support social and cognitive function for residents living in care. As part of the Quality of Life Chrysalis Project, these updates include a variety of changes to reflect residents' experiences and identities, including new visual and interactive enhancements.

At Mannville Care Centre, interactive murals, door wraps, and theme images were implemented, allowing each space to be more individualized, align with residents' identities, and support wayfinding in the facility. Thanks to support from Mannville Patient Comfort Fund Members, a Tovertafel was installed. The Tovertafel is an evidence-based interactive projector system designed primarily for people with dementia, that can turn any table or floor surface into engaging games that promote physical movement and social connection, improving the quality of life and mood for users.



Media Backgrounder: Quality of Life Chrysalis Project

- The Chrysalis Project is a two-year initiative dedicated to creating quality of life and environmental enhancements in continuing care centres.
- The project follows the Butterfly Care Home Approach from the UK and leverages input from residents and care workers. The evidence-based interventions include therapeutic technologies, interactive murals, and life stations that reflect residents' experiences and identities, while supporting memory, social connection, and wayfinding for those with cognitive challenges.
- The project is part of a **\$7 million investment from the Government of Alberta** to support the transition of continuing care homes to more home-like environments.
- Through the Chrysalis Project, **26** continuing care facilities across Alberta's Central Zone are being transformed, with all interventions expected to be in place by summer 2026.
- The evolution of the Chrysalis Project was inspired by the first successful care home improvements that happened at Tofield Health Centre in 2021, led by Recreation Therapist, Nicole Kulba, and assisted by students from the University of Lethbridge.
- The Quality of Life Chrysalis Project Team includes Nicole Kulba (Project Lead, Recreation Therapist), Vanessa Massey (Recreation Therapist), Delaney Epp (Recreation Therapy Assistant), Smiley Rana (Recreation Therapy Assistant), Michelle Sharpe (Professional Practice Lead - Recreation Therapy), and Process Improvement Teams (PITs) at each site who help the transformations take shape.
- These innovative transformations are supporting the expansion of person-centered living environments where residents feel a sense of dignity, purpose, and joy as they age.
- To ensure lasting impact, the project team will create educational sessions to support staff knowledge, continue to leverage the Feasible and Sustainable Culture Change initiative (FASCCI model) to embed person-centred care into daily practice, and Process Improvement Teams will continue operating indefinitely.
