Council News

Highlights from the Regular Council Meeting held on June 16, 2026

- Council endorsed a motion to approve the 1200-09 Privacy Management Program Policy with amendments.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the 1200-09-01 Privacy Breach Procedure as presented.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve the reimbursement of \$296.63 for the Sewer Main Back-Up located at 5043-52 Street.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve a contribution of 50% of the flagpole replacement cost at the Cenotaph located at Mannville School, to a maximum of \$3,500.
- Council endorsed a motion to approve a discounted water rate of \$4.50 per cubic metre for Utility Account 5370.001, applicable to the portion of water consumption attributable to ACE Water Corp. during Phase 7 Waterline Replacement project in July, August, and September 2026.

REMINDER TO PROPERTY OWNERS COMMUNITY STANDARDS BYLAW 2010-764

The Village of Mannville would like to remind all property owners and occupants to maintain their properties in accordance with the Community Standards Bylaw #2010-764.

To help keep our community clean, safe, and attractive, please ensure your property is free of unsightly conditions, including excessive accumulations of waste and debris, derelict vehicles, and overgrown grass or weeds. As outlined in Section 2.2(h) of the bylaw, grass and weeds must not exceed 15 cm (6 inches) in height, including on vacant residential lots, adjacent boulevards, and the area between your property boundary and any adjoining road or alley.

Your cooperation helps keep Mannville a community we can all be proud of. Thank you for doing your part!

SUMP PUMPS AND GROUNDWATER DRAINAGE

The Village of Mannville would like to remind all residents that sump pumps and foundation drains are intended to discharge groundwater outside onto your property and must not be connected to the municipal sanitary sewer system.

Directing groundwater into the sanitary sewer places unnecessary strain on the system, especially during periods of heavy rainfall or spring runoff. This can increase the risk of sewer backups, reduce system capacity, and lead to higher operating costs for the entire community.

If your sump pump currently drains into the sanitary sewer, we encourage you to have it redirected so it discharges safely onto your property, away from building foundations and neighbouring properties.

Thank you for helping protect Mannville's wastewater system and for doing your part to keep our infrastructure operating efficiently. If you have questions about proper sump pump drainage, please contact the Village Office.
